

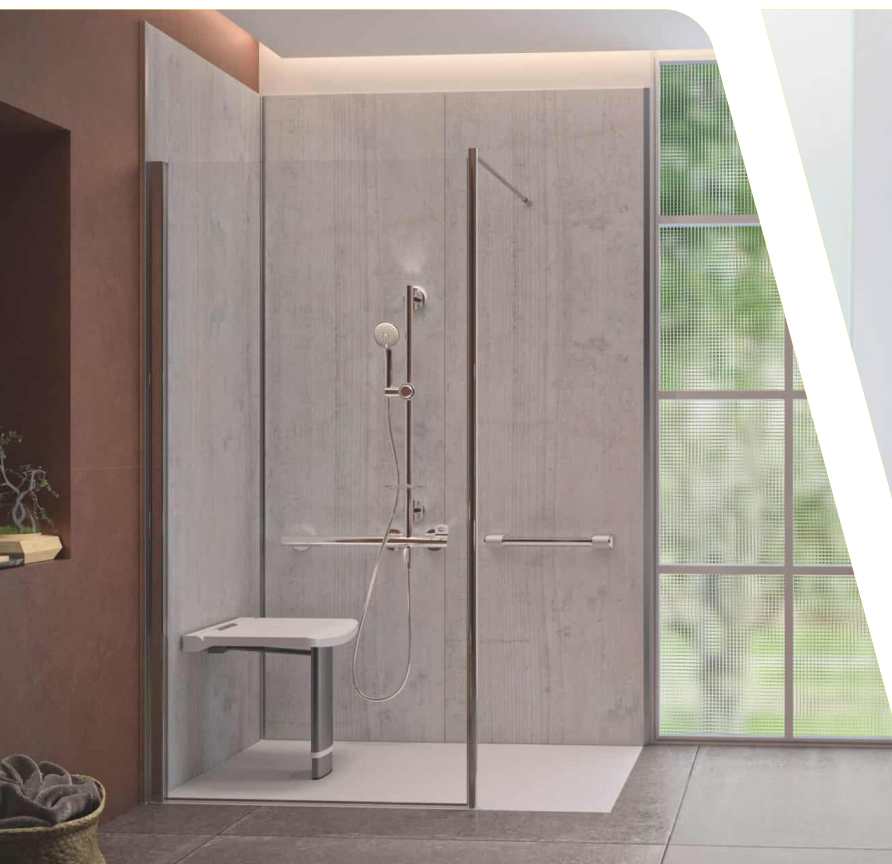


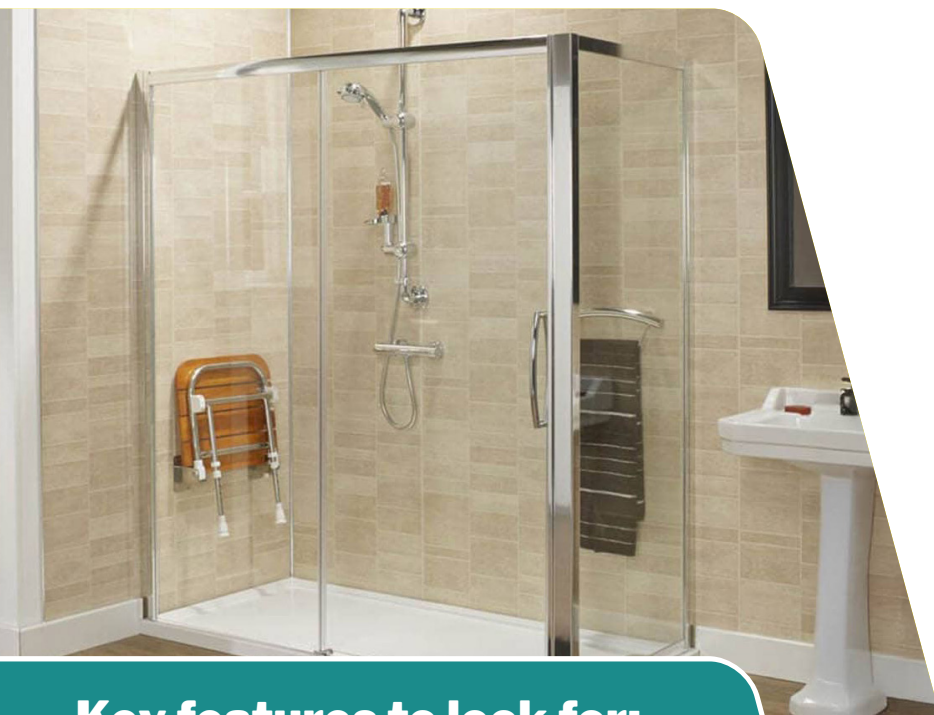
Key considerations when choosing a walk-in shower

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Entry height and accessibility

Stability and support

For added reassurance, consider what support features are included.

Look for:

- Securely fixed grab rails
- A comfortable, stable seat
- Non-slip flooring
- Well-positioned controls within easy reach

Showering position: standing or seated

Some people prefer to stand; others feel safer seated.

When choosing a shower, think about:

- Whether you need a built-in or fold-down seat
- The height and depth of the seat
- Legroom and positioning
- Ease of adjusting the shower head while seated

The right setup should feel natural and relaxed.



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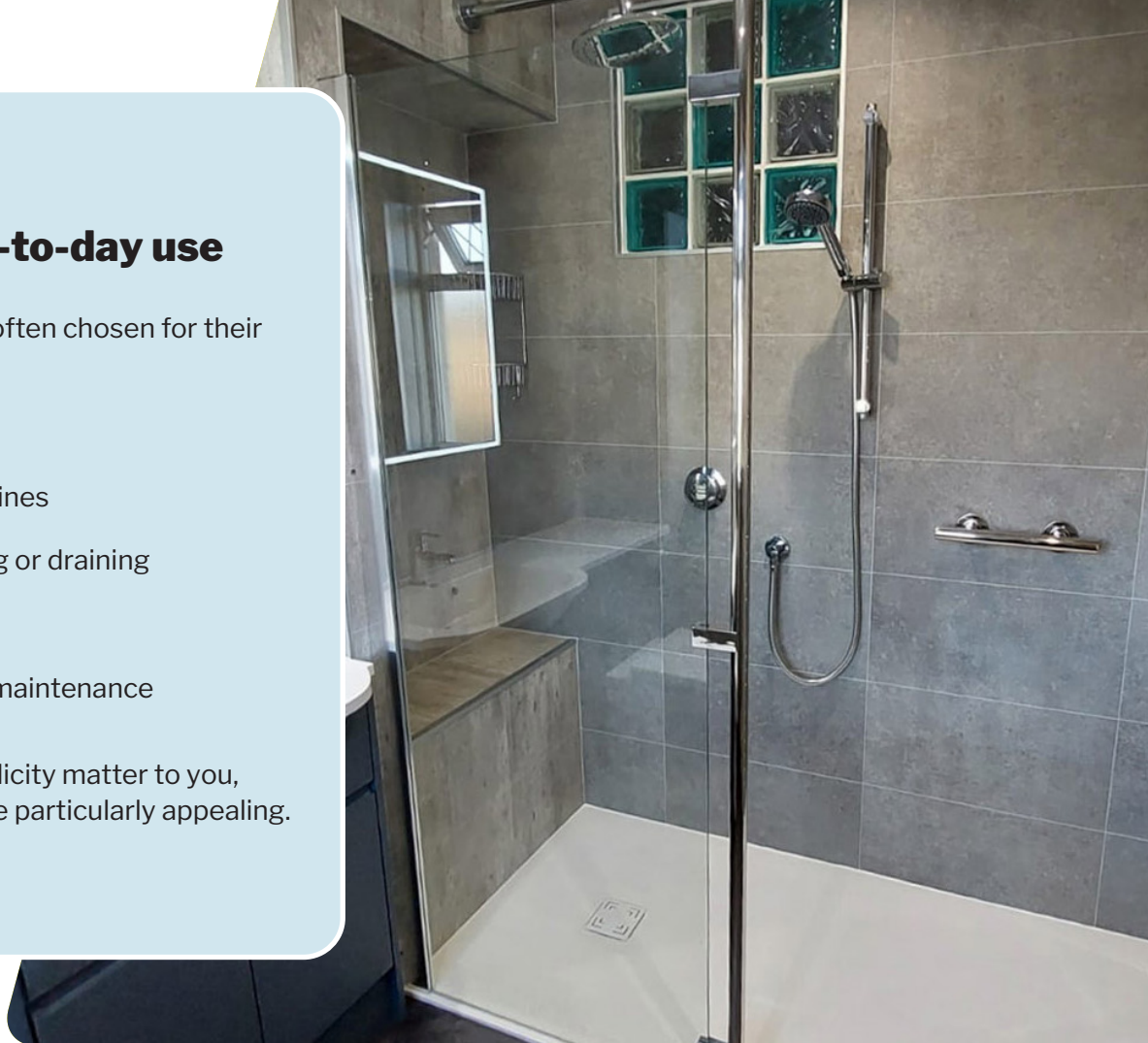
Practical day-to-day use
